A Comparative Study To Find Out The Problems Of Nursing Students Studying In Private Colleges As Well As In Govt. Nursing Colleges.

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ABSTRACT-There are rapid changes all over the world in the concept of patients care this is due to the better understanding of psychological needs of patients and the advancement in educations and civilization in the country to meet the complex need of patients. The educational system should also be changed in order to prepare nursing leaders in education field and ultimately patient care will be improved Nurses in India forms the huge segment of healthcare service and works as a backbone of hospital. Strengthening the nursing workforce in India is a need of the hour to provide holistic care to the patient and also render updated knowledge and skills to budding nurses. The Nursing students have to take more responsibility during their training period of specialization. But the nursing students have very little facilities during their study periods. They have many problems such as physical facilities in the nursing institutes, Hostels, clinical experience. Theory and practice do not co-relates with each other

II. METHODOLOGY

As the study being mainly a survey type in nature mainly the questionnaire method is used. The procedure adopted to collect the data is discussed under the following title.

TYPE OF STUDY

Comparative study to draw valid general conclusions from the facts discovered. The questionnaire is related to the different aspects as mentioned here-

The 'A' part of the questionnaire was to get opinion regarding educational problem.

The 'B' part of the questionnaire was to get opinion of clinical Experience and problem.

The 'C' part of the questionnaire was to get opinion about work load.

The 'D' part of the questionnaire was to get opinion about miscellaneous problem.

Result- Total 60 students [30 from each institute] of B.sc. nursing 4th year Students have been chosen because they have more experience than others and investigator visited both private and Government institute in Meerut district. The data analysis done section wise-

The 'A' part

. The students for Government Institution facing problem due to new Nursing techniques are 36.7% (11 subjects) and 53.3% (14 subjects) for private. 36.7% for Govt. [11 subjects] and 13.3 % (4 subjects) for private are overloaded with assignments. 63.3% of Govt [19 subjects] and 33.3% (10 subjects) of private institute students are agree, that their demonstration showing on patient in the ward.

The 'B' part

. The private hospital students are getting very less experience then Government Institution.56.7% (17 subjects]for Government and 33.3% (10 subjects) for private agree that they are getting proper community health experience. 63.3% (19 subjects]for Government and 36.7% (11 subjects) for private agree that they have provision for clinical teaching.60% (18 subjects]for Government and 36.7% (11 subjects) for private that the Doctors are interested to teach them.

The 'C' part

53.3% (16 subjects) for Government and 46.66% (14 subjects) for private are getting physical exertion during clinical teaching. 73.3% (22 subjects) for Government and 40% (12 subjects) from private said that they are getting enough articles to do their practical work. from

The 'D' part

80% (24 subjects) for Government and 43.3% (17 subject) form private have proper accommodation facilities.63.3% [19 subjects]for Government are agree that they have facilities for extra-curricular activities and 63.3% (19 subjects) form private that they don't have facilities for extracurricular activities . 40% [12 subjects] from Govt. and 80% form private institution, they do not have Indoor and outdoor games facilities. Both the institutions not providing regular medical checkup to their students. In both the institutions students and teachers are maintaining good relationship.

Conclusion- This study reveals that the students of Govt. institutions are more satisfied with the infra structure, clinical training and facilities, teaching leaning process, evaluation process, extra-curricular facilities, in comparison to private institutions where students are facing problems in some areas like- clinical , evaluation, library facilities, extra-curricular faculties, hostel accommodation .

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
